

## Asphalt Pavement Alliance 2024 Perpetual Pavement Awards

Antigo Construction, Inc. (Antigo) is proud of its contributions to many projects that have received Perpetual Pavement Awards (PPA) from the Asphalt Pavement Alliance (APA). The Perpetual Pavement Awards began in 2001 to highlight asphalt pavement projects that are at least 35 years old, have not suffered a structural failure and have an average interval between resurfacing of no less than 13 years. The awards program was expanded in 2020 to include two new project categories – PPA: By Conversion and PPA: By Design.



**PPA: By Conversion** recognizes new asphalt roads that meet Perpetual Pavement criteria and are constructed over an existing road. The **2024 PPA: By Conversion** awards recognized the West Virginia Division of Highways I-77, Kenna to Fairplain, project located in Jackson County. Antigo rubblized the existing jointed reinforced concrete pavement prior to it being overlaid with asphalt with project completion in 2018.

The **2024 PPA: By Conversion** awards recognized the Washington State Department of Transportation's I-5 southbound project located in Clark and Cowlitz Counties. Antigo cracked and seated the existing jointed plain concrete pavement prior to it being overlaid with asphalt with project completion in 2021.
